### **Job Descriptions**

Chair a committee:

- Vendors
- Clean Up/Tear Down
- Ticket Sales/ID Check Station

Set up:

- Assist vendors in locating their appointed location
- Put up signs, maps, banners, etc. in preparation for opening
- Position trashcans where needed

ID checks:

- Check photo identification for the craft beer tasting or beer garden
- Possibly assist with beer ticket sales
- Put on armbands

Ticket Sales: Sell NC Brew Fest tickets on Friday or beer garden ticket sales on Saturday

Merchandise Sales: Sell souvenir t-shirts or beer steins

Clean Up/Tear Down:

- Pick up trash and make sure area is clean following the event
- Move road barriers to open roads once the area is safe for traffic
- Assist vendors with tear down and moving equipment off the festival grounds

Monitor an Area:

- Walk an assigned area of the festival to be sure vendors have what they need
- Pick up discarded trash
- Direct festival attendees to restrooms, vendors, etc. when needed
- Periodically count the number of people in your area

Keg Runner:

- Check in beer kegs to the cold storage at the City Pavilion
- Run a golf cart back and forth from the festival grounds to the City Pavilion
- Deliver kegs and/or ice from the City Pavilion to vendors upon request
- Assist Craft Brewers with anything they need
